The Deyo Reservoir Recreation Site is looking for good natured people to serve as campground hosts for the camping season.

The most important job of a campground host is to provide an enjoyable camping experience for the public. Hosts are expected to assist visitors with information about the campground and local recreation opportunities.

They must be personable and neat in appearance and physically able to perform tasks such as clean and stock restrooms, pick up litter, perform fee compliance, post daily reservation signs, water trees, now and water grass, clean fire pits and remind campers of leash laws and fire restrictions (when in fire season).

The season length is Memorial Day through Labor Day, but could vary depending on usage. Volunteers must provide their own trailer.

FDR will provide a campsite with water, sewer and power. A subsistence allowance may be available, depending on usage.
